



"Counting the Omer" - verses of faith, day by day

II-10, Sun, April 28, 2024

This is the **1st day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and it is the **15th day of counting the 50 days** as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Ezekiel 34:11-15

(11) For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.

(12) As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day.

(13) And I will bring them out from the people, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land, and feed them upon the mountains of Israel by the rivers, and in all the inhabited places of the country.

(14) I will feed them in a good pasture, and upon the high mountains of Israel shall their fold be: there shall they lie in a good fold, and in a fat pasture shall they feed upon the mountains of Israel.

(15) I will feed my flock, and I will cause them to lie down, saith the Lord GOD.

John 10:27-28

(27) My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

(28) And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.

II-11, Mon, April 29, 2024

This is the **2nd day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **16th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Luke 15:4-5

(4) What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost, until he find it?

(5) And when he hath found it, he layeth it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

John 10:14-16

(14) I am the good shepherd, and know my sheep, and am known of mine.

(15) As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.

(16) And other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be one fold, and one shepherd.

Isaiah 53:5-6,12

(5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

(6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

(12) Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

II-12, Tue, April 30, 2024

This is the **3rd day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **17th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Luke 18:31

(31) Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished.

John 10:11

(11) I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

Isaiah 53:7

(7) He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.

1 Peter 2:22-25

(22) Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

(23) Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

(24) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

(25) For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

II-13, Wed, May 01, 2024

This is the **4th day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **18th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Isaiah 40:11

(11) He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the lambs with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young.

Micah 5:4

(4) And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth.

Psalms 95:6-8

(6) O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

(7) For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice,

(8) Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, and as in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

Hebrews 12:25

(25) See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven:

Galatians 5:16-17

(16) This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

(17) For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

This is the **5th day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **19th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Romans 8:5-8

(5) For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

(6) For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

(7) Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

(8) So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Job 6:11

(11) What is my strength, that I should hope? and what is mine end, that I should prolong my life?

Psalms 119:174-176

(174) I have longed for thy salvation, O LORD; and thy law is my delight.

(175) Let my soul live, and it shall praise thee; and let thy judgments help me.

(176) I have gone astray like a lost sheep; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments.

Matthew 9:36

(36) But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

Romans 8:11

(11) But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

This is the **6th day of the 3rd week of 7 weeks**, and
it is the **20th day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

Isaiah 43:7

(7) Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

Deuteronomy 32:6

(6) Do ye thus requite the LORD, O foolish people and unwise? is not he thy father that hath bought thee? hath he not made thee, and established thee?

Deuteronomy 3:24

(24) O Lord GOD, thou hast begun to shew thy servant thy greatness, and thy mighty hand: for what God is there in heaven or in earth, that can do according to thy works, and according to thy might?

Isaiah 64:8

(8) But now, O LORD, thou art our father; we are the clay, and thou our potter; and we all are the work of thy hand.

Psalms 139:14

(14) I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: marvellous are thy works; and that my soul knoweth right well.

Psalms 100:3

(3) Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

Psalms 31:5

(5) Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth.

it is the **21st day of counting the 50 days**
as commanded in Leviticus 23:15-16.

This day is the **3rd Sabbath of 7 Sabbaths**, and
it completes the **3rd week of 7 weeks**.

Psalms 100:4-5

(4) Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

(5) For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

Revelation 7:13-14,16-17

(13) And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence came they?

(14) And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

(16) They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

(17) For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

Hebrews 13:20-21

(20) Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

(21) Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
